

Parent/Carer Fees and Funding for Nursery Places

Our Nursery:

Circle Centre operates with two main functions:

- an early years setting providing access to the EYFS and free entitlement (term time only) to nursery education for 2, 3 and 4 year-old children
- a provider of specialist education and therapy for children who have special educational needs (as defined by the 1996 Education Act and the 2014 Children and Families Bill). Autism Early Support Trust Limited heavily subsidises the specialist provision at the Circle Centre Nursery.

It costs the charity approximately £158 per session for a child to attend the Specialist Nursery and receive the help we offer. Funding for this is sourced through;

- Statutory Funding
- Parent Contributions for specialist teaching and therapies
- Fundraising
- Sources of statutory funding to provide our services still leave a significant gap that we ask parents to help bridge.

Fees and Funding:

A £50 non-refundable Registration Fee is payable prior to the pre-admission meeting, to cover administration costs.

Local authority - sources of statutory funding

• Parents must agree to enable AES to claim the Early Years Education Grant for their child (when eligible). If we are unable to claim the Early Years Education Grant, parents will be charged the equivalent amount. (This is currently £11.93 for a 2.5hour session.) This funding is for the delivery of the EYFS curriculum.

This is funding that is in addition to the contribution for specialist teaching and therapy you will be asked to make.

• Parents who claim disability living allowance for a child aged 3 years or older can nominate AES to claim the **Disability Access Fund**. This fund is an additional £828.00 per child per year. It is issued to a setting to assist towards the costs of supporting a child with additional needs. At Circle Centre we use these additional funds to assist with the cost of the specialist provision within the nursery. If your child is attending a dual setting, only one setting can be nominated on the funding form in your admissions pack. We would be very grateful if you would consider nominating Circle Centre for receipt of this additional fund.

Income is also received from Local Authorities (LAs) when an Education and Health
Care Plan (EHCP) has been agreed for a child and Higher Needs Funding (HNF) or
equivalent is made available. Most children who attend our nursery eventually obtain
some level of LA funding for a portion of the cost of their place at the nursery, either
through their EHCP or HNF.

Parent Contributions for specialist teaching and therapies

Parents of children at the Specialist Nursery are asked to contribute to Autism Early Support Trust Limited's costs as follows:

These contributions are payable in advance on the 1st of each month by Direct Debit, based on a minimum of 3 months.

If a child is in receipt of an EHCP with our nursery named in Section I, and once our agreed rate of fees for LA's is paid by the LA, parents are entitled to a 50% discount on their contributions for up to 6 sessions (15 hours) from the date the agreed payment is received by Autism Early Support from the LA.

These contributions from parents are non-refundable in the event of a child's absence

In the event of a nursery closure due to instances beyond our control, these contributions will not be refundable unless it is deemed appropriate to do so.

Any family that would face difficulties in meeting these contributions, and which has household income of less than £25k pa, may qualify for financial assistance from the Autism Early Support Trust. Please ask for further details.
